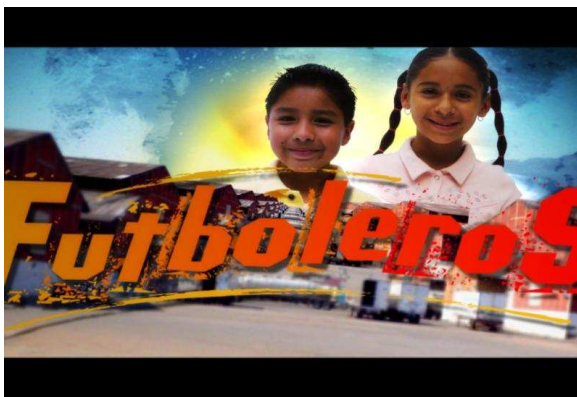


Cinco de Mayo Film Fiesta!
