The Festival exposes underserved and minority children to positive media images of people like them, at the same time showcasing the diverse experiences of children from across the globe. Among the several hundred celebrities and media professionals who have attended the Festival over the years include Shia LaBeouf, LeVar Burton, Jake Gyllenhaal, Jane Seymour and Timothy Hutton.
