



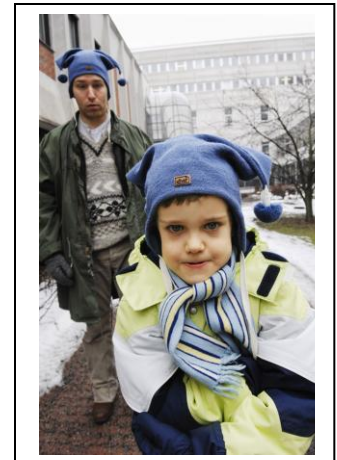
## Available for 2012-2013 School Year No Bullies, Please!

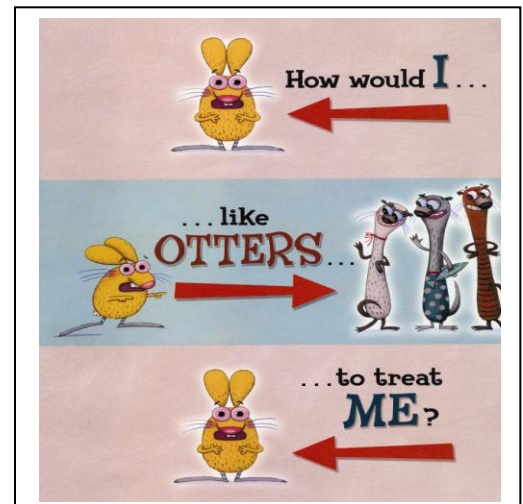
