In furtherance of her mission to spread tolerance and understanding to our youth, Klein recently founded *Citizenship Counts*, a 501 (c) (3) nonprofit organization that provides a middle school curriculum for civic education The program launches October 24th in Phoenix and, in Spring 2009, Justice Sandra Day O'Coonor will officiate at the program's first student-planned and led naturalization ceremony.

Her books include her autobiography, <u>All But My Life</u>, as well as <u>A Boring Evening at Home</u>; <u>The Hours After: Letters of Love and Longing</u>, which she co-wrote with her late husband, Kurt; and <u>The Blue Rose</u>, a story of a young developmentally-disabled girl, named Jenny.
