YOUNG FILMMAKERS (AGES 6-14, AGES 15-18) **ENTRIES, RULES AND REGULATIONS**

WHO WE ARE: The Chicago International Children's Film Festival (CICFF) is the largest annual, competitive film festival in North America, screening and awarding prizes for the best kids' films from around the world. Last year, the CICFF showed 288 films from 47 different countries, including three separate programs of short films made by kids!

WHAT WE DO: We show films that are made for (and by) young people. We accept all kinds of productions: animated films, live-action films, funny films, sad films, artsy films, documentary films and serious films. A Selection Committee made up of children, filmmakers, and teachers views all entries received by our deadline and recommends films for screening and competition. Three separate juries of 60 children and teens watch all of the competition films and decide who is going to win.

WHY YOU NEED TO CONTACT US! If you're a young filmmaker with a film that's ready to hit the big screen, send it to us. If accepted, it will be shown with other kid-produced films in a real theater to hundreds of other kids- many of them filmmakers just like you!

WHO CAN COMPETE? We're looking for young filmmakers, aged 6-14 or 15-18, who have made their own films/videos and would like a chance to have their work screened at the 2014 Festival. Submitting your work is absolutely free! (If you're over 18, download the adult entry form instead at www.cicff.org.)

WHAT CAN YOU WIN? Selected films compete for the Best Child-Produced Prize and Best Youth-Produced Prize. All films made by young filmmakers will be judged by either a children's jury for filmmakers ages 6-14, or a youth jury for filmmakers ages 15-18. There will be a first and a second place award from each jury. Awards are given in the form of certificates.



READY?

HOW DO YOU KNOW IF YOUR FILM IS RIGHT FOR OUR **FESTIVAL? HERE ARE SOME GUIDELINES:**

- The whole film must be your work, with very little adult help. It's okay if an adult supervised, as long as you came up with the ideas and created the film.
- > Films have to be new, made in 2012, 2013 or 2014.
- > Very important: Films must be available in a format that we can show.

If you're submitting your film, it must be in one of these formats:

- **DVD**
- ▶ Upload your film to YouTube and provide us with the link. (You must provide the link directly to the video you are submitting, not to your channel.) Submit your film ONLY if you can provide a copy of it in one of these two formats. Vimeo not allowed.

DOES YOUR FILM MEET THOSE GUIDELINES? IF SO, COLLECT THE FOLLOWING STUFF FOR YOUR ENTRY:

- > Completed Young Filmmaker's Entry Form signed by parent or guardian. (One form per film. You can mail us a printed copy. Forms are available on our website as PDF downloads: www.cicff.org.)
- > YouTube link for your uploaded video OR a DVD of your film. (Label the DVD with your film's title. Put only one film per disk. Putting more than one film on a disk will disgualify your entry.)
- A short biography: tell us a little about yourself and how many movies you have made in the past!
- 2 images from your film. (E-mail to <filmreg@facets.org>.)

THEN WHAT HAPPENS? We'll let you know by August 31st, 2014 whether your film has been selected for the festival. (Your DVD and other materials for entry, accepted or not, will **NOT** be returned.)

If your film has been chosen, you'll get more details in August. We need to have the final screening copy of your film by September 16, 2014.

DON'T BE LATE!

May 31st, 2014 is the entry deadline. Entry must be postmarked by this date.
